

The Medical Faculty of the Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg offers a

Junior-Professorship (W1) for Public Health and Health Services Research.

The initial appointment is for three years followed by an interim evaluation in the third year. A tenure track evaluation for a W2-professorship takes place in the sixth year after starting the service. The professorship is situated at the Institute of Social Medicine and Health Systems Research (Director: Prof. Dr. Dr. Christian Apfelbacher).

The successful candidate ought to have expertise in one or more Public Health and/or Health Systems Research areas. An emphasis on new digital technologies (e.g. development and evaluation of telemedicine in health care or digital public health) is beneficial. An integration of the candidate's expertise into the Medical Faculty's two core research fields (neuroscience, immunology incl. molecular medicine of inflammation) is desirable. Methodological expertise in empirical research is a prerequisite. Furthermore, the candidate will take into consideration aspects of translation into practice/implementation as well as gender and diversity issues in health research and will contribute to the further development of research methods. We also expect the candidate to collaborate within the Medical Faculty and University as well as with research groups and consortia in Magdeburg.

Prerequisites are a university degree and a doctorate obtained less than 6 years ago (public health, epidemiology, psychology, health and social sciences, medicine or related fields). The successful candidate has excellent publications in the field of research and has contributed to the successful acquisition of third party funding. Teaching experience is desirable. We anticipate the candidate to establish a working group in a field of interest. The position includes supporting the institute's teaching in medicine in the subjects "social medicine", "prevention/health promotion", "medical sociology" and "exploration of vocational fields".

The Otto von Guericke University aims to increase the proportion of women at all stages of the academic career and therefore urges female scientists to apply.

Applications of severely handicapped people will be treated preferentially if they are of the same suitability, aptitude and professional qualification.
